These diseases cause changes in the brain that impair verbal communication skills, and practical techniques are provided that can enhance communication. Learn why social connections are beneficial for individuals with memory loss and how to effectively facilitate social engagement and personal connections.

- Describe how Alzheimer's disease and dementia can change the abilities and methods of communicating.
- Identify practical techniques for effective communication with individuals who have dementia.
- Demonstrate methods that can reduce and even prevent challenging behaviors associated with dementia.
- Identify new skills that enhance well-being for individuals with memory loss.
