Alzheimer's Orange County postpones annual gala

Out of an abundance of caution because of concerns brought on by the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, Alzheimer's Orange County ("AlzOC") announced that the nonprofit organization will postpone its annual fundraising gala, which had been set for March 21. The event is now set for August 22 at the Balboa Bay Club and will be combined with its annual 2020 Visionary Women's Luncheon.

"We highly value the well-being and health of our community and have since early January been tracking the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, putting into place recommended policies to protect the health and safety of our participants, staff, volunteers and friends," AlzOC's CEO and President Jim McAleer said.

"We have decided to postpone the gala after recent governmental recommendations and warnings issued by the CDC and California Public Health Department. After consultation with our executive board members, community leaders and staff, we feel this is the only responsible course of action."

AlzOC will reach out to registered guests to see if they prefer to leave their donation with the organization and attend the August 22 gala, or want to have their gift refunded.

"Though we will miss the opportunity to see you all this month, we look forward to continuing our valued partnership that augments the positive impact we can have on so many others."
