I want to thank all of you for taking such good care of my mother Bryna. As you may not have known, over the past two years as my mother has descended deeper into dementia, I have had her in over five 'care' facilities. It has not been easy for mom, as she is also mostly blind from Macular Degeneration and her disease has made her afraid of everything. Not knowing where to turn for help anymore, I wrote an email to Dr. Dupont, who I had heard of through another facility and the Alzheimer's Association of Orange County. She called me within 20 minutes of my email to discuss mom and our situation. This was around Christmas time and as I thought everyone would be celebrating the holidays, I did not expect help to come anytime soon. I told Dr. Dupont that mom was in a facility that left her in a large room where she kept repeating "I'm scared, I'm scared". It broke my heart. Additionally, mom is diabetic and they were not giving mom her medicine and had been feeding her all the wrong diet. Dr. Dupont told me she would have Kim call me and arrange a meeting -- even though it was a couple of days before Christmas. Christmas came right on time for me and mom. You and your staff had mom moved into one of your Irvine Cottages - at Christmas time - and everyone set about making mom comfortable, safe, and feel secure.

Mom has been in Irvine Cottages for over six months now and all of your staff have treated her with patience and dignity! In particular, Alfred Ruvivar does a great job caring for mom and making her feel loved and secure. I rarely hear mom say that she is afraid now. As mom's dementia gets worse, I am not always sure that she knows who I am anymore, but her face lights up when she hears Alfred's voice. Thank you, thank you,
